

Guide to Applying for Financial Support at Stanmore College

Welcome to Stanmore College's guide on how to apply for Financial Support using our online bursary application portal, Pay My Student. This guide includes further information on what Financial Support is, how it is paid, and how you can apply.

Who is Financial Support For?

Financial Support is aimed at eligible students who have difficulties meeting the costs associated with studying at college. Please make sure you read the <u>Bursary Fund Guidelines</u> before making your application.

What Types of Financial Support Are Available?

- 1. The Young Person Bursary
- 2. The Adult Discretionary Bursary which includes Advance Learner Loan and Childcare Funding for students aged 19+
- 3. Further Education Free Meals

What Do I Need to Do for My Payments?

All payments are subject to excellent attendance, good behaviour and satisfactory progress in your studies at Stanmore College. If your attendance falls below 90%, or you are absent for more than a week due to being suspended, going on holiday or long periods of illness, your bursary payments may be stopped or adjusted.

What Happens if I Leave the College?

If you leave or are withdrawn before the end of your course, the Bursary funds spent on supporting you may be repayable to the college.

How Do You Manage the Volume of Applications for Financial Support?

Once all Bursary funds have been allocated, we may be unable to accept further applications. If we receive more applications than we have funding for, then payments may be reduced to ensure all students have fair access to financial support.



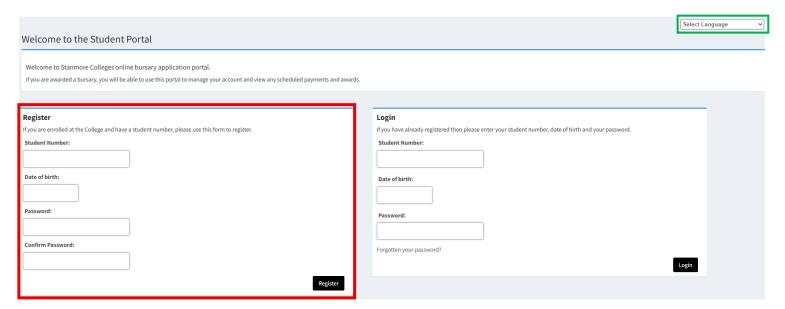
How to Apply for Financial Support

Step 1 - Registration

Firstly, you must be enrolled at Stanmore College before you can apply for Financial Support. After you have completed your enrolment, you will need to register to use the portal:

Click the link https://stanmore.paymystudent.com/portal/. Please complete the registration section (red box)

- ⚠ Registration will be available 24 hours after you have enrolled.
- ≥ NOTE: Returning students are not required to register again. Please go directly to Step 2.
- Please be careful not to add any spaces before or after your student number as your student number will not be recognised. You can change the language by using the dropdown menu in the top right-hand corner of the page (green box).



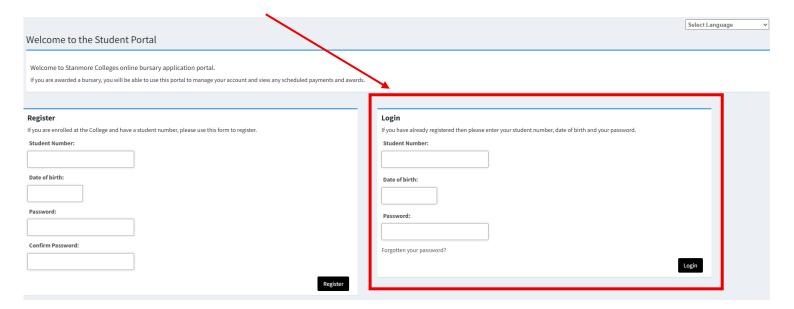
Once you have filled out the registration box, fill out the activation page. Click submit to send the activation email to the email address you used, then access that email and activate your account by clicking the link

MOTE: Please allow some time for the email to come through. If you do not receive anything, please ensure you check your junk folder.



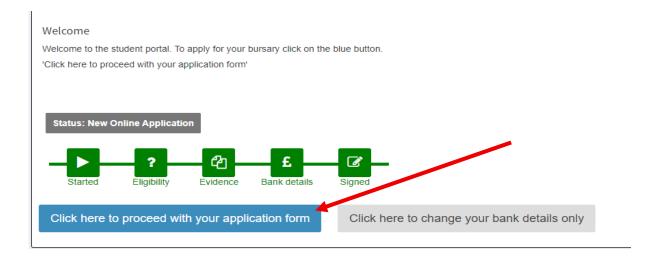
Step 2 - Log in

Close your tab then re-open https://stanmore.paymystudent.com/portal/. Login with the same details you just created when registering in step 1 - use the box on the right-hand side this time



Step 3 - Start your application

Now you are on the homepage, you can start your application. Select the 'Click here to proceed with your application form' button (red arrow)



<u>Step 4 - Personal Details</u>

Your personal details and course information should now appear on the screen (red box). It is very important you check that all the information on this page is correct.



✓ If the information is correct, please make sure you have selected the correct campus you will be studying at, then click Next (green box)

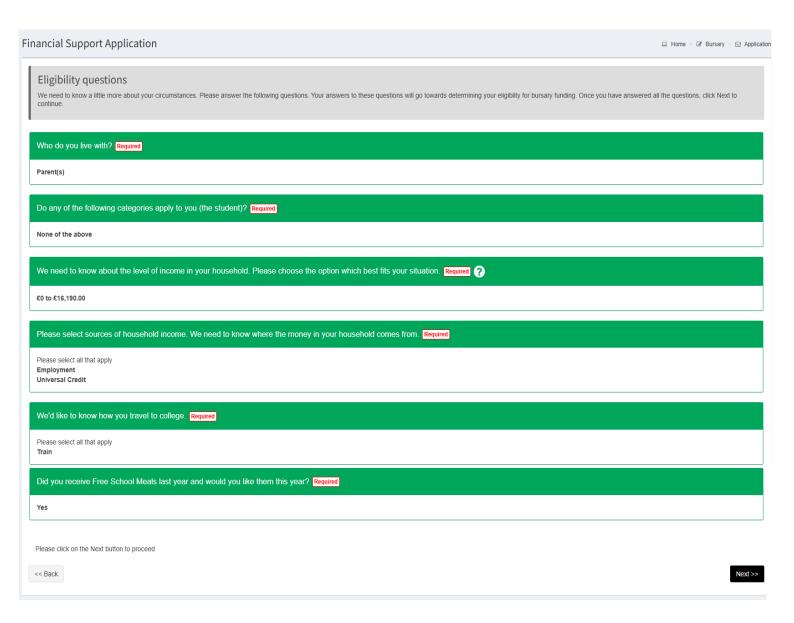

Step 5 - Eligibility Questions

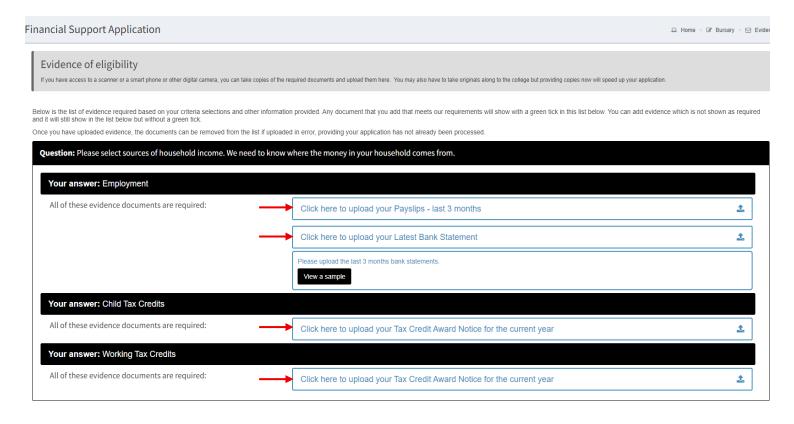
Step 6 - Evidence of Eligibility

You will now need to upload the relevant evidence to support your eligibility assessment. We will ask for the relevant pieces of evidence based on the information you have already provided us.

Use the 'Click here to upload' buttons (red arrows below) to upload your evidence. It can be uploaded as photocopies, photos or screenshots.

⚠ Please ensure that all pages of the document, including blank pages are provided and are readable. Failure to do so will result in your bursary application being delayed.

⚠ All evidence must be uploaded. Please do not email your evidence as they will not be accepted. If you are having issues uploading your evidence, please visit the Bursary Team for support.



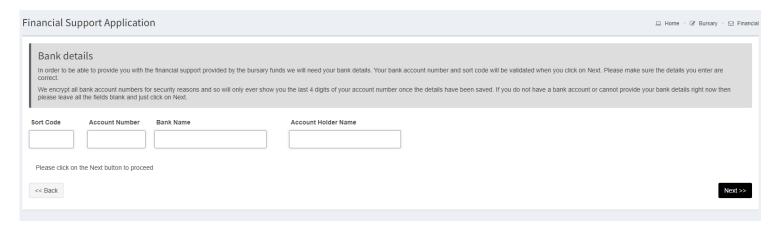
If you would like to delete an upload, please press the bin button on the right of the upload button.

Once you have uploaded all documents, click 'Next'.



Step 7 - Bank Details

Please provide the bank details of the account you want the bursary payments to be made into. If you were a student last year, your bank details should automatically appear, but if you want the payments to go into a different account now, please re-enter the new account details



NOTE: if you want to change your bank details in the future, please fill out a change of bank details form, which you can get from reception



Step 8 - Summary Page

Please read through the summary of your application. Ensure that the information is correct.

Then, read the Declaration and Terms of Support, and if you agree, tick the box to confirm "I agree to the declaration" and sign your name.

You will then need to click submit application.

⚠ Please make sure you click on the submit button, otherwise your application will not be sent.
